

WDP Field Season General Packing List

Please pack light, and use a duffel-type rather than hard suitcase, as there is very minimal storage on board.

	Day clothes: shorts & tees
	Boat-appropriate shoes (no black-soled street shoes – will scuff boat deck)
	Nightwear
	Long sleeved top & long pants in case of cool evening weather
	Windbreaker/rain slicker/sweatshirt
	Bathing suits (2 is good)
	Snorkel gear - Mask, Snorkel, Fins, and Thin Dive Socks (for snorkel fins) or
	Booties (for dive fins) are required (none available onboard, you must bring your
	own)
	• Test your equipment in water before boarding <i>R/V Stenella</i> to prevent
	abrasions, wounds, cuts, or blisters (This has happened and it may negate
_	you from participating in encounters with dolphins and snorkeling)
	Wet suit if you use one
	Two towels (1 swim towel, 1 shower towel)
	Personal toiletries – everything you'll need for 10 days
	Hat, Sunglasses (& a spare?)
	Sunscreen – NOTE: Please do not bring spray sunscreen, just the lotion type
	Reading material, e-reader, DVDs, CDs or mp3 player, etc.
	Camera, extra memory cards (still photography only; GoPro cameras & other
	similar video cameras are not allowed on board)
	Any prescription medications must be in your name, unexpired, and
	IN ORIGINAL PHARMACY PACKAGING ; OTC meds must also be in
	original packaging. Unidentified medications may be confiscated at customs.
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	Passport (Yes, it has happened. We clear customs twice. You will not be
	permitted to board without it)
	Snorkel gear . No gear is available onboard. Make sure it's in good condition, it
	fits, and you are comfortable in the water. It is required to test your snorkeling
	gear (Mask, Snorkel, Fins, and Thin Dive Socks or Booties) in water before your
	trip on board R/V Stenella.
	Cash: Minimum of \$20 for Bahamas departure tax; this <i>must be in cash</i>
	 Other cash needs might be taxi fares, WDP T-shirt, book, or other
	merchandise purchases, and anything on land (before or after trip) that you
	won't be able to use a credit/debit card.
	<u>Chargers</u> for electronics: camera, phone, and laptop. There is no phone or
	Internet service at sea but you'll want those items up and running when you
	return. There is power on board so you can charge your items.

Meals onboard: Please let us know <u>early</u> if you have any dietary restrictions. Please list it on your application.
