

# Cancellation and Travel Insurance:

Cancellation notifications must be received at least 60 days prior to your scheduled trip. Cancellations must be in writing; verbal cancellations cannot be accepted.

The Wild Dolphin Project monitors the status of domestic and international travel throughout the field season. In the event you are unable to get to our point of departure due to sudden travel restrictions or border closures imposed by either local governmental authorities or your country of residence, we will either (1) transfer your booking/reservation to a later date or (2) issue a credit for you to join us during a different field season. Under no circumstances will WDP issue a full or partial refund due to such travel restrictions or border closures. The Wild Dolphin Project highly recommends you explore coverage options for travel insurance. The Wild Dolphin Project monitors U.S.A. and Bahamas travel related requirements and will work with participants to understand and comply with any new regulations immediately.

Travel Insurance: The Wild Dolphin Project recommends that you consider purchasing short-term travel insurance and trip cancellation coverage through your insurance agent or travel agent to protect yourself and your equipment if your health, weather, or boat circumstances make it necessary to cancel or interrupt your trip. This additional insurance may reimburse you for non-refundable air travel and WDP trip costs in case of cancellation. Unfortunately, due to adverse weather conditions, mechanical failure, health issues, or other travel related hazards, last-minute itinerary changes or cancellations may be unavoidable. We highly recommend looking into travel insurance that fits your needs.
