Dr. Denise Herzing, Research Director of the Wild Dolphin Project, has completed 41 years of her long-term study of the Atlantic spotted dolphins in the Bahamas. She is a Ph.D., an Affiliate Assistant Professor in Biology at Florida Atlantic University, a Guggenheim Fellow, and a fellow with the Explorers Club. She is co-editor of *Dolphin Communication and Cognition*, author of “*Dolphin Diaries: My 25 years with Spotted Dolphins in the Bahamas*”, “*Is Anyone Listening? What Animals are Saying to Each Other and to Us*”, and “*The Wild Dolphin Project*”. Her work has appeared in *National Geographic*, *BBC Wildlife*, and on Nature, Discovery, PBS, ABC, BBC, NHK, PBS, and TED2013. In 2025 she made the TIME100AI list for her work with AI and decoding dolphin communication.
